Create Complex Passwords

Passwords should be at least 12 characters in length and have a balance between its length and your ability to remember it. There is no point in creating a 32 character password that you will have difficulty remembering.

Use Password Management Software

Password managers are pieces of software that are used to generate and store passwords for multiple accounts, locking them behind a single, strong master password.

Use Multi-Factor Authentication

MFA should be used on all accounts that need a password. MFA will generate a random token which you will need to supply to login into your account. These tokens can be sent to your phone or generated through an app.
